

# systemd boot into console

```
cd /lib/systemd/system
ln -sf multi-user.target default.target
```

or alternatively:

```
systemctl set-default multi-user.target
```

you might need to pass "text" rather than "quiet boot" to your kernel through grub (in ubuntu, edit /etc/default/grub then run update-grub)

## Autologin to console

in '/lib/systemd/system/getty@.service' find the line:

```
ExecStart=-/sbin/agetty --noclear %I $TERM
```

and change it to:

```
ExecStart=-/sbin/agetty --autologin username --noclear %I $TERM
```

## Autostart some scripts upon every login

edit `~/bash\_profile`
